To encourage students to become members of the AIP, free membership is offered to all third year physics students (normally \$25.00). The AIP has therefore decided to extend this offer to honours and postgraduate students for the year 2002 who have not previously been members of the AIP.

To be eligible students:

- must be studying physics at an Australian university physics department
- they must not previously have been members of the AIP (ie this only applies to new members)
